## Suggested Itinerary

Times are approximate. This is just a suggestion of how to tailor your trip. Feel free to deviate from this itinerary, and do/eat whatever suits your family and budget!

### **Day One**

- 4pm Arrive at Givhans Ferry State Park  
Check-in to cabin at park office  
Receive Historic Coastal Tour Packet, Tickets, Vehicle Tag
- 4:30pm Head over to your cabin & unpack
- 5:00pm Take a sneak peak at Givhans Ferry State Park, the Edisto River, and all the park has to offer
- 6:00pm Unpack the groceries that you brought with you and prepare for dinner or head down the road to Bee City, Duke's BBQ, or into Summerville, SC – choices include: Breck's, The Mustard Seed, Fisherman's Quarters, Sticky Fingers and more!
